

## Bequests to St John's Parramatta

### Terms of a General Bequest

The following words could be included in a will for the purposes of making a testamentary gift for the general purposes of St John's ministry.



“To the wardens of the time being of St John's Anglican Church Parramatta to be applied for such purposes of the parish in which the church building is situated as may be determined from time to time by a majority of the parish council of the parish or if there is no parish council, by the majority of the wardens of the church. The receipt by any two of the wardens shall be a sufficient discharge for my executors”.

Where the proposed amount of the gift is \$20,000 or more consider making the gift to the Anglican Church Property Trust (ACPT), Diocese of Sydney, for the purposes of St John's Parramatta.

The ACPT are the corporate trustees for the Diocese and have wider investment powers than the wardens. In this case, the wording would be:

“To the Anglican Church Property Trust Diocese of Sydney to be applied for such purposes of the parish of St John's Parramatta as may be determined from time to time by a majority of the parish council of the parish or if there is no parish council by the majority of the wardens of the church. The receipt by the Secretary of the Anglican Church Property Trust Diocese of Sydney will be a sufficient discharge for my executors”.
